BOARD OF SUPERVISOR'S MINUTE BOOK
CHEROKEE COUNTY, IOWA
JULY 13, 2010

The Cherokee County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Tuesday, July 13, 2010 with Jeff Simonsen, Larry Prunty, Dean Schmidt, Mark Leeds, and Terry Graybill present. Mike Leckband, *Chronicle Times*, represented the press. Unless otherwise indicated, all votes were offered as follows: Ayes – Schmidt, Graybill, Prunty, Leeds, Simonsen; Nays – none; Abstentions – none.

Motion by Leeds, seconded by Schmidt to approve the agenda and minutes of the previous meeting. Motion carried.

Dave Shanahan, County Engineer, introduced summer interns Clifton Spengler and Tom Wilson. Shanahan discussed repairs on flood damaged bridges and presented a wage authorization.

Motion by Graybill, seconded by Schmidt to approve a change of position for Clifton Spengler from summer intern to Tech 2 position with an \$18.21 wage authorization. Motion carried.

Jake Schutt requested approval for a temporary liquor license in rural Cherokee County. Schutt informed the board that his business, Jake's Sports Lounge, will be joining other groups from Aurelia to provide food and refreshments along the RAGBRAI route. Schutt has obtained DRAM insurance for the temporary location and has completed all the proper state licensing requirements.

Motion by Graybill, seconded by Prunty to approve a temporary liquor license for Jake's Sports Lounge at 2138 610th Street south of Aurelia on July 25, 2010. Motion carried.

Motion by Schmidt, seconded by Leeds to approve the county claims as presented. Motion carried.
