Motion by Simonsen, seconded by Mongan to approve the County Recorder's \$83,685.75 March 31, 2016 Quarterly Revenue Report with \$21,759.40 retained by the county. Motion carried.

A Memorandum of Understanding with CAEDC for county funding of economic development services was tabled for further consideration.

An engineering services agreement between Cherokee County and ISG Field Services, LLC identified as "County Inspection for Dakota Access Pipeline Project", was tabled for review by the County Attorney.
